The Cossack Union was officially formed in Shanghai in 1925 and continued to exist until they had to evacuate to Tubabao, Philippines in 1949. From Tubabao the Cossacks started to migrate to Australia, Argentina, Chile, Dominican Republic, France, America, and any country that would accept them. They became active in San Francisco and officially registered as the "All Cossacks Union of San Francisco" in December 1949, where it was headquartered at the large Edwardian mansion on 900 Ashbury Street.*
